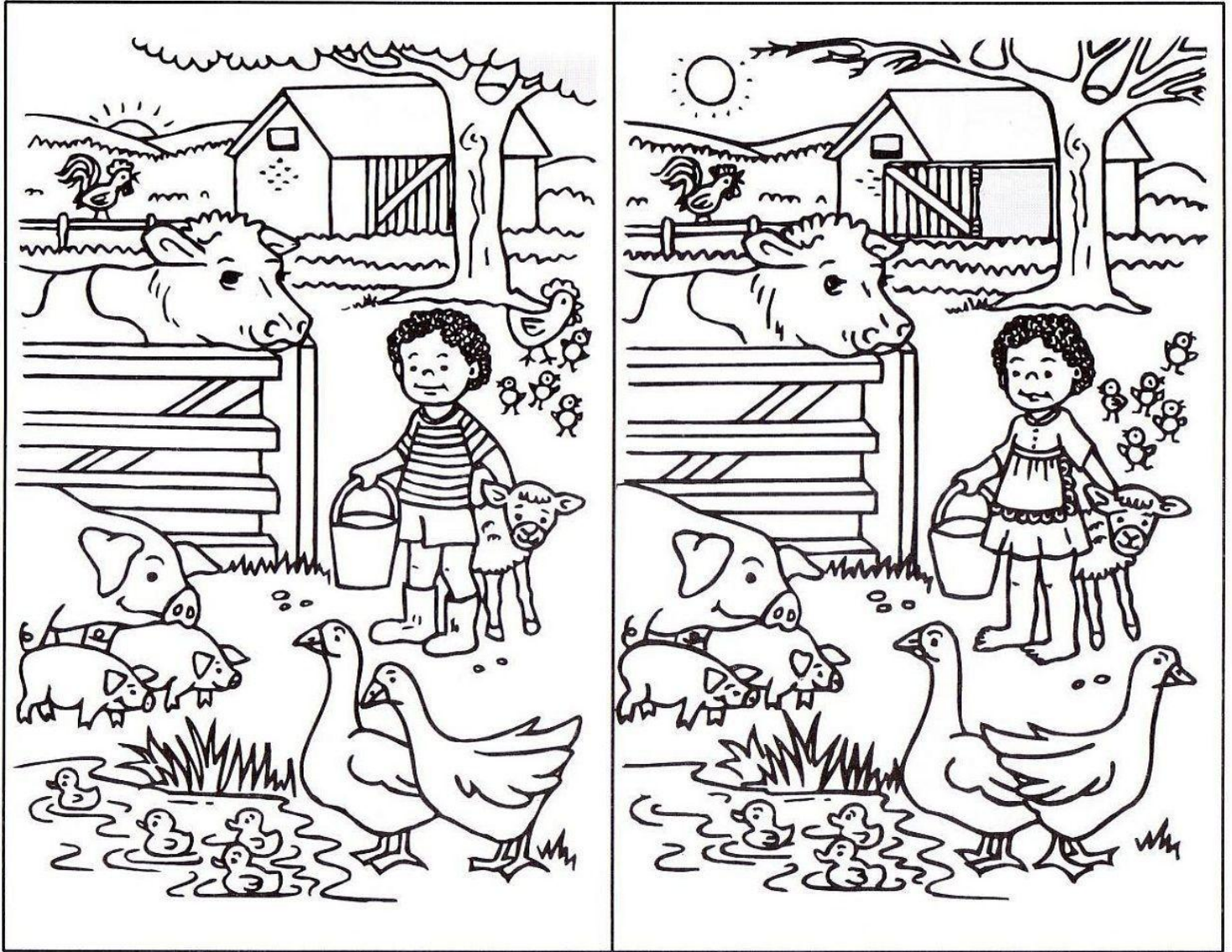


Rejoice and Weep (Romans 12:9-16)

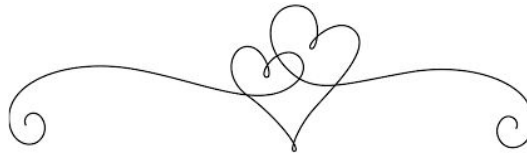
